1. About us

Name: Holland Heineken House

What is it: an initiative of the Dutch Heritage and Culture Foundation together with its loyal partners Heineken and Texas T Tavern.

Purpose: To establish a place for the Dutch and other soccer fans to call “Home” during the upcoming soccer tournament. A five-week long experience where we will celebrate soccer, culture & community. For all people who have “soccer fever”. We will celebrate this “the Dutch way” and welcome people of all ages, backgrounds and cultures to celebrate with us. Especially during the more Dutch events, we will have activities for kids, so the whole family is welcome.

The Dutch Heritage and Culture Foundation promotes, educates and preserves Dutch culture and heritage by organizing events and facilitating activities with similar purposes, connecting Dutch people and friends of the Dutch or people who somehow feel related to the Netherlands.

We organize cultural events like Sinterklaas, King’s Day, Dutch Happy Hours, and ad-hoc events like during sports events. Events are typically accompanied by Dutch food, live Dutch music, and traditions.

This summer we love to take the opportunity to show, share and celebrate our soccer culture and cheer as the Orange Legion is known for.

2. Reach / Community

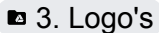
